DISMISSAL FROM SPECIAL EDUCATION ACADEMIC SERVICES

When dismissing a student from a special education eligibility, you **MUST** hold a reevaluation or a waived reevaluation (no testing needed) meeting. Please follow the appropriate checklist for all necessary paperwork. An exit form is also sent with the paperwork.

DISMISSAL FROM SPEECH/LANGUAGE AS A PRIMARY OR SECONDARY DISABILITY

Schedule a meeting. Complete the Referral for a Reevaluation (yellow packet). Conduct a domain analysis with particular focus on Communicative Status. If enough data is available, have the parent sign to agree that no testing is needed (follow the Waived Reevaluation Checklist).

If available data is not sufficient, then conduct a reevaluation (follow the Reevaluation Checklist). After data is collected, complete the eligibility meeting. Mark Not Eligible if the student has been eligible for Speech/Language only. If the student remains eligible under other categories, then only list the areas of eligibility and exclude Speech-Language. Remove Speech/Language services from the Educational Services and Placement page.

This process is only initiated by the speech-language pathologist.

DISMISSAL FROM RELATED SERVICES

Schedule an IEP meeting. Document on the IEP goal pages that the student has met all goals. Explain the dismissal on the Additional IEP Information page or in a written report. Remove the related service from the Educational Services and Placement page. If the services are being dropped as of the IEP date, document that. Otherwise, it is assumed that the services will be dropped at the end of the school year.

Services can only be dropped by the service provider.
